Ground-Level Gutter Cleaning - No Ladders, No Lifts, No Roof Access

Ground Force Gutters LLC is a veteran-owned Tennessee small business providing gutter cleaning for government, commercial, and institutional facilities across Middle Tennessee. Every job is performed from ground level with an industrial vacuum system - removing the ladders, aerial lifts, roof access, and work-at-height exposure that make conventional gutter cleaning an administrative problem for facility managers. Put simply: don't let your gutters become a liability.

CORE COMPETENCIES

- **Gutter cleaning by ground-level vacuum extraction** - debris pulled up and out into a sealed tank on one- and two-story buildings, performed entirely from a standing position on the ground.
- **Multi-building and campus service** - priced by gutter footage and access rather than by unit or door, delivered as a single scheduled action across an entire property.
- **Job documentation** - video of the work plus before-and-after photos of the areas cleaned, supplied as a digital report suitable for closeout files and inspection records.
- **Complete debris removal and disposal** - all material leaves the property; nothing is bagged and staged for facility staff to handle.
- **Recurring scheduled maintenance** - annual, semi-annual, and quarterly cycles with fixed pricing and advance scheduling.

DIFFERENTIATORS

- **No aerial equipment, no staging footprint.** No boom lift or scissor lift means no blocked parking, no obstructed sidewalks, and no ADA access route taken out of service during the work.
- **No roof contact.** Nobody sets foot on the structure. This removes the roof-access permit, the building-manager liability question, and any risk of foot-traffic damage to metal, tile, or slate roofing and fastener seals.
- **No work-at-height exposure.** Ground-level operation eliminates the fall hazard entirely - no fall-arrest equipment, no competent-person sign-off, no height permit, and no associated OSHA administrative burden for the facility.
- **Weekend and off-hours availability.** For buildings that sit empty on weekends, work can be scheduled when no one is on site - no disruption to staff, visitors, or operations.
- **Single point of contact.** Owner-operated. The person who quotes the work performs the work and answers the phone afterward.

HOW TO BUY

We price by gutter footage and access, not by unit or door, and quote within 48 hours of a site walk. Most single-building jobs fall below the FAR 2.101 micro-purchase threshold of \$2,500 applicable to services subject to the Service Contract Labor Standards - so an individual building can generally be acquired by Government Purchase Card without a formal solicitation. Certificate of Insurance issued on request with additional insureds named as your contract requires.
